Districts will be chosen for the Auxiliary Achievement Circle of Excellence by a combination of the completion of achievements on this form and a brief description of your District's accomplishments. To be considered this form must be filled out in its entirety and submitted by May 1, 2026.

On May 10, 2026 your points will be totaled and all Districts reaching 550 points will be welcomed into the Circle of Excellence and receive their award.
