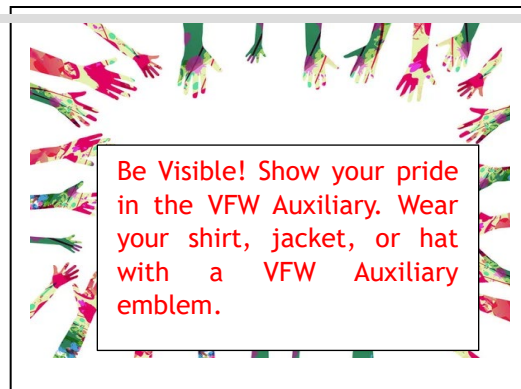
What is Auxiliary Outreach?

Auxiliary outreach is volunteer work performed by one member or group of members for the benefit of their community or its institutions. It is a donation of TIME, not MONEY. It is about partnering with other organizations in our communities.

To have an outstanding Auxiliary outreach Program, reach out into your community and find local groups and organizations in need of assistance. ASK what your Auxiliary can do to help them. Take the idea to your Auxiliary and ask to have it approved. When approved, form the partnership and report back to your Auxiliary with the details.

REPORTING:

- Auxiliary Outreach must be reported to your VFW Post Adjutant.
- Form can be found under HOME on the VFWA-WI website
- If what you are doing is reportable under another Auxiliary Program, report it under that Program, NOT Auxiliary Outreach.
- Auxiliaries are responsible for so many good deeds that help our communities. Collectively, all our projects need to be counted to show the importance of the Local VFW and VFWA
