Promotion of all program reports shall be read at each meeting.
- 2. General Orders must be read at each meeting. All program bulletins shall be read at each meeting. The Auxiliary and District program chairman should review the award system to understand the objectives for the year. In the absence of the chairman, it is the responsibility of the Auxiliary or District Secretary to communicate this information to the members.

- 5. The First Council of Administration and Chairmen's Promotional Meeting will be held at the Hotel Meade in Wisconsin Rapids, on July 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Friday, July 11<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. will be a training for the District President's, Sr., and Jr. Vice Presidents. The School of Instruction will begin at 1:00 PM. We will have a joint meeting with the VFW on the special project for this year. The Joint Kick-Off Dinner will be held at 6:00 p.m. On July 12<sup>th</sup> at 8:15 a.m. the Chairmen will present their programs for the coming year. At 1:00 we will have the Council of Administration Meeting.


Extending Property Tax Exemptions to 70%, 80% and


