

5 Essentials of a healthy Auxiliary

As we head in to Fall and hold our District Meetings and Official Visits, let's be mindful of the 5 Essentials of an Auxiliary:

- 1. At least 10 business meetings per year with a quorum of at least 5 members in good standing at each meeting.
- 2. Dues paid by at least 10 members for the current year.
- 3. Quarterly Audits by Trustees, submitted on time.
 - 4. Officers elected and installed and reported to National Headquarters.
- 5. Offices of the President and Treasurer MUST be bonded by August 31.

PIP: Performance Improvement Plan

When an auxiliary is struggling, a PIP Committee (not a suspension committee) is assigned to meet with the President, Secretary and Treasurer and under certain circumstances an individual member or members with the issues to discuss and develop a Performance Improvement Plan. The committee **OBSEREVES** the auxiliary and offers **MENTORING.** The PIP committee takes the lead and gradually gets the Auxiliary involved in correcting the issue, therefore; the auxiliary would not have to be placed on suspension. Once the issues is taken care of, the PIP committee advises the Department President that the auxiliary is now considered healthy!

SECTION 813- page 78 – TREASURER, DUTIES OF (ALL LEVELS) READS AS FOLLOWS - Section 'D'.

The Treasurer shall be the Treasurer of all Auxiliary Committees handling funds.

Meaning... that any and all donations of funds, gifts of money, or gift cards are to be entered as receipts for whatever Fund Raiser or Event that has been voted on prior to the event and used ONLY for that Event.

Any fund raiser for the Auxiliary needs to have a total Accounting of <u>ALL FUNDS RECEIVED AND ALL</u>

<u>EXPENSES (with receipts) so recorded in Ledger</u>

All monies at the end of the event shall be counted by a minimum of 2 people present and one is the Treasurer.

A receipt is then given to Chairman of Event for their record.

NOTE: DID YOU VOTE ON YOUR BOND?

Page 89 of the By-Laws under Section 814-E/2 states: The amount shall be approved by the body and the bond premium paid from their funds. A motion shall be made, passed and included in the Secretary's minutes.

Reminder: This Bond does not cover gaming accounts i.e. Bingo. Also, no need to make donations for Cancer.
