



Wisconsin is having a great Membership year. As of September 5th, the Mid-Year goals have been met for the following number of Auxiliaries: (I am using Paid Percents for my Awards.)

80% by 9/30/23	64 Auxiliaries
90% by 11/30/23	40 Auxiliaries
100% by 12/31/23	23 Auxiliaries

We have Auxiliaries that are 100+. They are <u>District 2</u>: 328 and 2260; <u>District 6</u>: 1393, 6707, and 9202; <u>District 9</u>: 10406. District 5 qualifies for the drawing for 95% by 12/31/23. Wisconsin is at 85.89% using the Paid Percentage on September 5, 2023.

This is a perfect time to start promoting our two Youth Activities Competitions – the **"Illustrating America"** Patriotic Art Contest and the **"Get Excited for the Red, White and Blue!"** National Anthem Singing Contest. Let's get the word out and encourage our youth to enter these contests.
