Wisconsin Legislative News

<u>SB8</u> and <u>AB26</u> relating to: the University of Wisconsin Missing-in-Action Recovery and Identification Project and making an appropriation.

SB102 and AB102 relating to: reducing the eligibility threshold to claim the veterans and surviving spouses property tax credit

SB16 and SB238 relating to: tuition and fee remission for certain veterans and their dependents enrolled in the University of Wisconsin System or a technical college.

SB693 relating to: free state park admission for veterans and gold star families.

<u>SB546</u> and <u>AB580</u> relating to: admission of spouses at veterans homes.

<u>SB727</u> relating to: creating a medicinal psilocybin treatment fund and a pilot program to study the effects of medicinal psilocybin treatment on patients with post-traumatic stress syndrome at the University of Wisconsin-Madison and making an appropriation.

National Legislative Issues

H.R. 234: Gerald's Law Act

2023-2024 Regular Session (118th)

Gerald's Law Act This bill requires the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to provide a burial and funeral allowance for a veteran who dies from a non-service-connected disability in a home or other setting at which the veteran was receiving VA hospice care (if such care was directly preceded by VA hospital or nursing home care).

H.R. 303: Retired Pay Restoration Act

2023-2024 Regular Session (118th)

Retired Pay Restoration Act This bill allows the receipt of both military retired pay and veterans' disability compensation with respect to any service-connected disability. Under current law, only individuals with service-connected disabilities rated at 50% or more receive both without offset. Individuals who were retired or separated after at least 20 years of military service due to a service-connected disability shall be eligible for the full concurrent receipt of both veterans' disability compensation and either military retired pay or combatrelated special pay.

CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is only for VFW Auxiliary members that have been a member for a full year, along with their family members such as spouse and children that are at least 21 years of age. Applications are available in MALTA Member Resources. Continuing Education Scholarship entries are due to the VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters by February 15, 2024. \$1,250 will be awarded to an applicant in each of the four conferences.

3-DIMENSIONAL PATRIOTIC ART

This contest is open to students in Grades 9-12 by the March 31 deadline who are enrolled in a public, private parochial, or home school program. Student does not have to be related to a VFW or VFW Auxiliary member to participate.

- Entry must be 3-dimensional
- Entry may be paper, paper mâché, pottery, fabric, wood, metal work, etc.
- Entry must not be larger than 18" in any direction
- Digital art, photography, weapons, art generated by a 3-D printer and jewelry are NOT accepted.

YOUNG AMERICAN CREATIVE PATRIOTIC ART

This contest is open to students in Grades 9-12 by the March 31 deadline who are enrolled in a public, private, parochial, or home school program. Student does not have to be related to a VFW or VFW Auxiliary member to participate.

- Entry must be completed during the current school year.
- Entry must be two-dimensional.
- Entry must be on canvas or heavy paper.
- Submit canvas entries on a stretcher frame or canvas board. If matted, must be matted in white.
- Reinforce the back with heavy Paper. Mounting and floating mats may be used. Do not frame art.
- Entries may not be smaller than 8" by 10" and not larger than 18" x 24", (not including a mat)
- If the American Flag is used, it must conform to the Federal Flag Code.
- Digital art and photography are NOT accepted.


