September is Veterans & Military Suicide Prevention and Mental Health Awareness month. Encourage Veterans and their Families to Reach out, contact a loved one, express their feelings, and / or to check in with a resource person, and encourage them to check in with you. Encourage the crisis line number 988 then press (1).

Set up displays at the library for Veterans and their families to pick up brochures, pamphlets, literature, etc., to view on mental health care, resource numbers, mental health care centers, VA, PTSD centers etc.

Auxiliaries could host, educate, promote, with or without their VFW Post an activity or event for Veterans, their families, on Military Suicide Prevention and Mental Health awareness => Invite the veterans and families, community, to Tea time, coffee social or group, book club for mental health/resources, have a speaker come in for education/resources on PTSD or abuse, Humana speaker on copays/funding, support group for caregivers, have a taco social, ice cream social.

Our mass emails to the members go through the National Webmaster’s company and servers. They try very hard to let your providers know that we are legitimate emails, however, not every provider is willing to work with the VFW. Yahoo, for instance, has not been cooperating and is not willing to whitelist our emails. Therefore, especially emails sent to a Yahoo address will fall into your junk mail.

Therefore, you really need to make it part of your routine that when you open your email program, make sure to check your Junk Mail folder, as well as your Inbox. Then when you find an email in there that is a good email, move it to your Inbox and let your program know that it is a good email and not junk.


