

Are You REAL ID-Compliant?

Effective May 7th, 2025, PCIF/PIV offices will no longer accept Driver's licenses or state-issued Identification (ID) cards that aren't REAL ID compliant. A REAL ID compliant can be identified by a star in the upper right-hand corner, which my vary in design and color. Please refer to the images below for examples of REAL ID-compliant state ID and Driver's licenses.



If a user doesn't have a REAL ID-compliant ID, PIV offices should remind them that they can use other forms of ID. A list of those IDs can be found linked in the *Primary Forms of Identifications* section of the <u>USAccess Acceptable Forms of ID Registrar Guide</u>.

Please check your Volunteer IDs! If you let it expire, you have to re-do your fingerpints!!

The home electronics recycling collection will be held outside Building 52, on the concrete pad in front of the building. Enter on 2nd Street of Tomah VA campus, turn left on "F" Street. Then right on 1st Street. The turn-in point will be on the left. Just follow the signs!
