- ⇒ PIV Cards Check Expiration Dates!! We are coming up to our 6 month of our new PIV's (Valid only 6 months). If you come in before their 6 months expires, you don't have to get new fingerprints, just get new card.
- ⇒ Starting May 7th, 2025, PIV Registrars will no longer be able to accept Driver's Licenses or stateissued Identification(ID) cards that aren't REAL ID compliant. Your card can be identified as REAL ID compliant if it has a star marking in the upper right-hand corner.
