
Current Volunteer Needs






New Parking Tags **for Volunteers driving personal Vehicles (not DAV vans) and parking at Tomah VA Attention all Staff, Students, and Volunteers, Police Services has new parking placards. Per SOP 006S-10 all individuals are required to obtain this new placard. Please fill out the Vehicle Registration Parking Permit form (attached) and come to the Police department in building 407 room 1717 in order to receive your placard. Please bring the following items with you:

- 1. Your Driver's License
- 2. Prior-issued parking tag (if in possession)
- 3. Filled out vehicle registration parking permit form

Upon issuance of the placard, place on the interior rear-view mirror facing out through the windshield or on the dashboard facing outwards. Upon sale of vehicle or separation from VA employment, employees must notify VA Police, remove the parking permit, and return them to VA Police.
