Hatch Act

Election year is in full swing and all of us must review and abide by the restrictions imposed by the Hatch Act on partisan political activities of Federal employees/volunteers this year and every year.

That Hatch Act restricts certain "partisan political activities" by Federal employees/volunteers. "Partisan political activity" is defined as activity directed at the success or failure of a:

- Political party;
- Candidate for partisan political office; or Partisan political group



A volunteer must not canvass or solicit support for any political party, candidate, or faction, nor do any act on their behalf while on duty as a volunteer. Volunteers are responsible for abiding by the HATCH Act, which imposes restrictions on partisan political activity. In general, a volunteer should not participate, advertise for (including wearing hats, buttons or other insignia) nor solicit support or contributions for a political candidate while on duty. They should also refrain from wearing any official VA uniforms or badges while participating in political activities while off duty. The department of Veterans Affairs remains a non-partisan government organization. All volunteers must keep this in mind while volunteering and refrain from discussing politics.





For the General Public:

Monroe County Health Department can file insurance claims for the influenza vaccines for most insurance companies. We will also bill Medicare Part B and Medicaid. However, we will bill the participant any amount that their insurance company does not cover.

Cost Without Insurance: Regular Dose \$30.00 / High Dose \$65.00
