Log on to www.vfwauxiliary.org/scholarships/continuing-education. Here you will get the application. The applicant must be 21 years old or older, a current VFW Auxiliary member, a spouse of a current VFW Auxiliary member, or a son or daughter of a current VFW Auxiliary member. The qualifying VFW Auxiliary member must have been a member of the VFW Auxiliary for one year by the application submission deadline of February 15th .

Four \$1,250.00 scholarships will be awarded each year, one in each of the four VFW Auxiliary Conferences. Each applicant must answer all questions on the Continuing Education application. They must also write a brief essay (no more than 300 words) describing their commitment to their goals and how this scholarship will help them attain these goals. The application process began on July 1st; the start of the new program year. All applications must be submitted to VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters by February 15, 2026. Scholarship recipients are notified by May 1, 2026.
