

Dept of WI Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary Ways & Means 2024 Money Raffle Rules & Procedures



The Department of Wisconsin VFW Auxiliary will conduct its

own fund-raising raffle. This year's money raffle is called "Let's Pair Up to Help Our Veterans" and offers 52 money prizes over the months of October thru December 2024.

Wisconsin Raffle License Laws for a Class "A" Money Raffle we must live by:

- All Raffle Tickets must be accounted for and **all stubs handed in**. Please keep accurate records of all the numbers you are assigned.
- Absolutely **no tickets or monies may be returned through any mailing system**, i.e. USPS, UPS, FED EX.
- Class "A" raffle tickets may be purchased by anyone over the age of 18. Buy them for your auxiliary, sell to your post and auxiliary members, but don't forget that you can also sell them to neighbors, friends, and the general public.
- Winners need not be present.
- Drawings will be held at Noon on days noted at the Department Treasurers office.
- Prize winners will receive their winnings in the mail and they will be listed on the Wisconsin VFW Auxiliary website at <u>www.wivfwaux.org</u>

Distribution of Raffle Tickets

- All tickets will be packaged for the auxiliaries and distributed to the District Presidents at the C of A meeting after Installation. District Presidents will sign for the tickets.
- If attending, auxiliary representatives may get their raffle tickets from their District President.
- Line officers & District officers will also be assigned raffle tickets.
- A cover letter, a rules & procedures page, and a marketing poster will be in each packet of raffle tickets.
- District Officers will get the auxiliary packets of tickets distributed to their auxiliaries as quickly as possible. Deadline is by Saturday, July 13th.

Procedure for remitting the money raffle stubs and checks.

- The Auxiliaries will place all stubs and your auxiliary check in an envelope clearly marked with your District, Auxiliary Name and Number on the front.
- Auxiliaries should write one check for all of the raffle tickets payable to the WI VFWA– In the memo: Let's Pair Up to Help Our Veterans. <u>Please- no cash or personal checks.</u> <u>Auxiliary checks only.</u>
- District Presidents will work with their auxiliaries to collect the auxiliary envelopes by September 13th and State Officers and the Ways & Means co-chairs will collect from the District Presidents by September 15th.

These funds are used to help our General Fund and to fund veteran programs in Wisconsin. With your wonderful help, Wisconsin VFWA will continue to give our Unwavering Support to our Uncommon Heroes, and we can spend the year "Honoring Veterans Together".
