R.A.P. CARDS

Have you seen a child respecting our flag or thanking a veteran? R.A.P. Cards are a fun way to say, "Thank you" and "Good Job" to boys and girls who support veterans or display patriotism.

ILLUSTRATING AMERICA

While we have the Young American Creative Patriotic Art competition for our high schoolers, Illustrating America is a patriotic art contest open to all students in grades K-8. Their artwork will be judged on patriotic theme and technique. Please remind students to **follow all the rules** included on the entry form! The contest consists of these three grade divisions: K-2, 3-5 and 6-8. Entries must reach local Auxiliaries by March 31, 2025. Auxiliaries can then send their first-place winner in each grade division to me by April 15, 2025. First, second and third place awards will be given out at both the Department and National level in all three grade divisions. Applications and other information can be found under Youth Activities on our Wisconsin website or on MALTA Member Resources. In 2022-23, we had a first-grade student take the second-place spot in the Grades K-2 division in the National Contest. Our talented students can achieve this again — **Go, Wisconsin!**





PATRIOTISM THROUGH LITERACY

This program fosters a lifelong love of reading among our youth, introduces them to various American events and people, and helps them to understand our history better. It also gives us a chance to spend time with kids in our community in new, creative ways. How can your Auxiliary participate in Patriotism Through Literacy? Some ideas include:

- Volunteer to read a patriotic book at your school or local library.
- Donate historical and patriotic books to area schools, shelters or libraries.
- Host a read-a-thon with prizes or run a writer's workshop for young authors.
- Invite an author of historical fiction or non-fiction for a book talking or signing.

The National VFW Auxiliary offers a Patriotic through Literacy Suggested Book list that will help you out with this program. If you donate books, there are labels available that you could place inside each book. Reading has many benefits for children – increased grammar and writing skills, improved focus and concentration, better understanding of the feelings of others and a widening of their imaginations. As Dr. Seuss famously said, "Reading can take you places you have never been before."

National Youth Activities Ambassador Dominique Garcia is emphasizing this year how books can forge a bond between veterans and children. She invites us to host a day of reading – veterans reading to kids or kids reading to veterans. Choose a book from the Patriotism through Literacy List. You can meet at your local library, schools, VFW Post, VA Hospitals, Veterans Nursing Homes, etc.

YOUTH ACTIVITIES NATIONAL PROGRAM AWARDS

In fact, this year's the National Youth Activities Program Awards are for the most outstanding activity and/or event of youth reading to veterans and/or veterans reading to youth. Your Auxiliary should go for it! A citation and \$25 goes to one VFW Auxiliary in each of the 10 Program Divisions. Auxiliaries must send their entry form to me by March 31, 2025.
